3. The Context

Prabhu Jagatbandhu College has a diverse student body, with women making up more than 50% of the total enrollment. Despite this, women have historically faced challenges in accessing the same opportunities as their male counterparts. Our women empowerment initiatives aim to bridge this gap and create a level playing field for all.

4. The Practice

The Women's Cell, Prabhu Jagatbandhu college is prospering hard to uphold women's issues including awareness among the girl students relating to health and hygiene issues. The Women's Cell understands the importance of bringing awareness to all gynecological problem. Early diagnosis of gynecological problem with effective and common screening programs is very important in reducing mortality and morbidity rates. It is recommended to maintain healthy lifestyle behaviors, avoid risky behaviors, screen risky groups and ensure women's awareness for primary prevention. For this purpose, the Women's Cell is planning for an awareness workshop on women's health and hygiene. The cell is planning for a program in the presence of a specialist doctor so that all women of the college can discuss their intimate health problem with him/her and get benefited.

5. Evidence of Success

The Women's Cell, Prabhu Jagatbandhu college have installed a sanitary napkin vending machine in this college for women students. By using this anyone can immediately access to napkins anytime of the day to meet menstrual emergencies. Convenience of purchasing the product independently. Self dispensing of the napkin at the drop of coin. Saves the

embarrassment of seeking napkins in the peer group or from authorities. Women will be provided with easy access to sanitary napkins across their college. This will not only provide easy access, but also help to empower women and create awareness about women's health. This vending machine will be turned up as a feminine hygienic product. Working procedure of vending machine is simply designed where young girls can easily operate it, does not require power consumption.

6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required

Initial resistance from some sections of the community, addressed through continuous dialogue and sensitization programs. Need for ongoing funding to support scholarships and new initiatives.

The women empowerment initiatives at Prabhu Jagatbandhu College have made significant strides in creating an inclusive and supportive environment for women. We remain committed to advancing these efforts and exploring new ways to empower our female students and staff.
