Best Practice No. 1

1. Title of the Practice:

Heritage Walk to help students, faculty, and the community connect with local history, culture, and heritage.

2. Objectives of the Practice:

- **Educational Enrichment:** To provide participants with insights into the historical, cultural, and architectural significance of heritage sites, fostering a deeper understanding of local history and traditions.
- **Cultural Preservation:** To raise awareness about the importance of preserving historical landmarks and cultural heritage, encouraging community involvement in conservation efforts.
- **Community Engagement:** To promote interaction among residents and visitors, fostering a sense of pride and connection to the heritage of the area while supporting local businesses and tourism.

3. The Context:

Heritage walks or heritage trails has become a common tools used by local groups of community to promote local history and heritage. A heritage walk is a symbolic and pioneering activity to start heritage management-related activities. It is also used to enhance public awareness to-ward heritage object and heritage conservation.

Heritage Walk is aimed at creating awareness about the importance of monuments in a civilised society and encourage people to protect heritage sites that will be sustainable for the future generations. Heritage Walks gives one an opportunity to learn and educate themselves about the history of their city in a more fun and interesting manner. It imparts new knowledge, de-mystifies the myth, and creates interest in the people. It's like knowing

something you have never known before. A “Heritage walk” is conceived by and with those who live and work in a territory or have a special affinity with it.

Our College is situated near the bank of Sarswati river. The Andul Rajbari is a palace or Rajbari near Kolkata in Andul, Howrah district, West Bengal, India. The rajbari is now a heritage site of Andul and is a popular destination.

The Practice:

Students from Geography, History, Political Science, Sociology are encouraged to enroll for the Heritage Walk. Coordinators has been assigned for each department. The programme are announced through the various means like notice board, classroom announcements, etc. Students are participated in a gala heritage walk at Andul and other heritage places in Kolkata (Asutosh Meuseum, College Street).

5. Evidence of Success:

- Celebration of Heritage Week (25-27 November, 2023).

A seminar has been organized in collaboration with Pashimbanga Sangrahalaya Samiti. Some eminent resource persons, historians, cultural experts highlighted their views on heritage historical events, architectural styles and cultural practices of Andul and other heritage sites of India. Around 600 students and faculties have participated in the seminar and heritage walk.

6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required

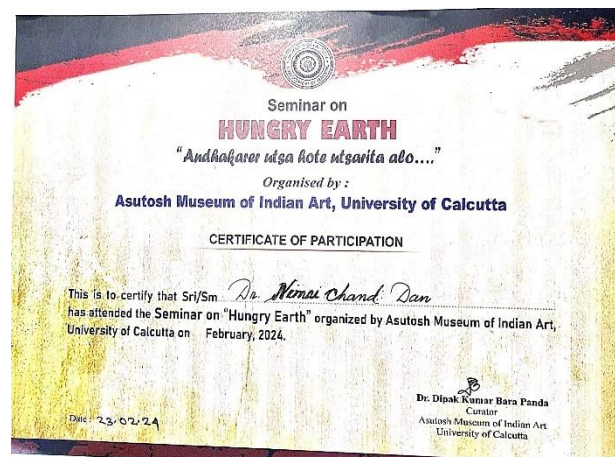
- Limited resources for conducting the programmes.

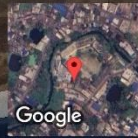

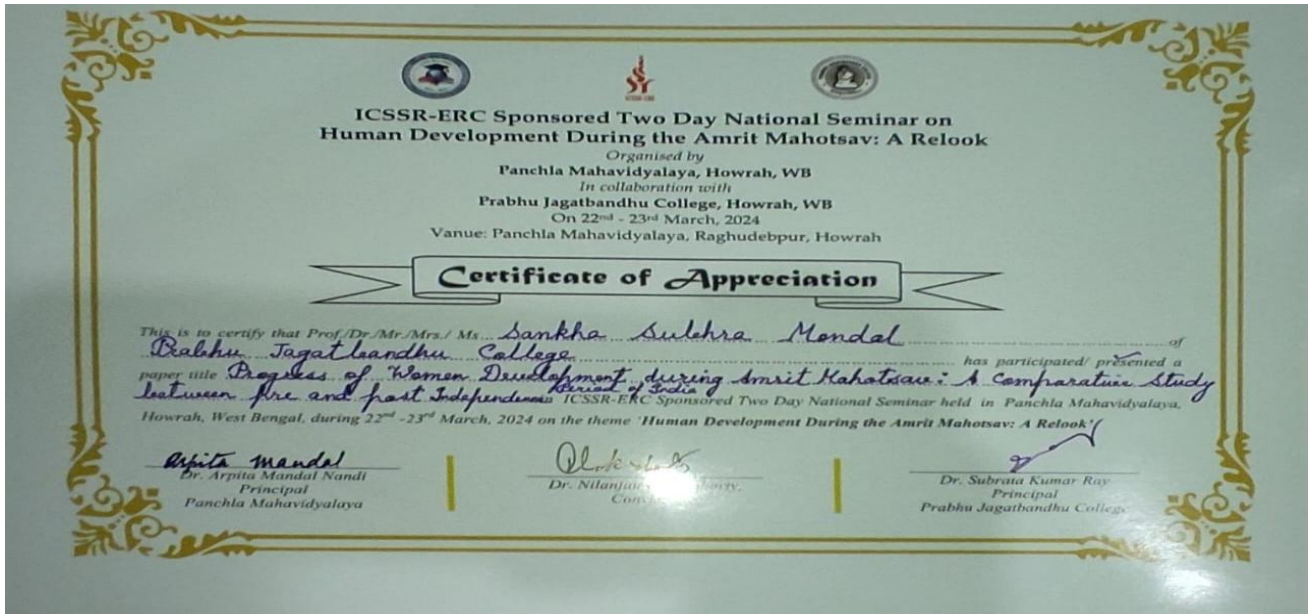


